the clinton administration without being predictive or legalistic they offer instead commentary analysis and criticism that examine the legality and constitutionality of president clinton s actions within a broader political and historical context the presidency is constitutionally weaker and politically more vulnerable than the office bill clinton assumed in 1993 and it remains to be seen what impact these changes will have on the presidency in the 21st century this book points the way to assessing that impact and is essential reading for anyone concerned with the future of our democracy
